Thought I would inform you about my latest "Bryston experience". Some time ago I bought an MPS-2 power supply for my BP-25 and got a big improvement from that. And according to you and some reviews, too, it was the power supply which was the important part in the BP-26 preamp set-up. The old BP-25 could do an almost as good job as the new BP-26 with the MPS-2 added. I was happy for that, especially since it saved me from an additional outlay on the BP-26.

But Tor (at T.AA.import) kept on "pestering" me about changing also the BP-25 with the BP-26. Then I would get a real high-end preamp, he maintained, better than most on the market. So, reading the letter from Don Clarke, which you posted on your web-site, I finally gave in and allowed Tor to send me a BP-26 on trial.

I have had it now for almost two weeks. After a couple of days, I could not in any way accept to live without it! It was that much better. I can a hundred per cent endorse all that Don Clarke has written. The BP-26 was quite simply -yes - a "revelation"

I am sorry to say, James, that the BP-25 was sent to Tor as an exchange for the BP-26. But It has been a good companion for several years - but it was time to part.

So now I am living happily with a fantastic preamp - the complete BP-26 setup.
